# The “Greatest Fourth in the North”

## Food Vendor Information

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This celebration brings an estimated 25,000 people into our community during its 5 days of events. We feature a grand parade, beach volleyball tournament, children’s parade and entertainment, 10k, 5K, 2K, vendors, crafts, ox roast and much more. We also feature free nightly entertainment, which are held on our downtown City Park Free Stage. Our general merchandise vendors and our food vendors are placed in the parking lot right next to this location, between the park and beautiful Lake Missaukee.

Please read the following information carefully, so we may avoid any unanswered questions or problems during the event.

- \* No Parking on Main St. at any time.
- \* No parking in the City Park Parking lot other than at set up or tear down times.
- \* Maps will be provided showing your space location if you are accepted and we will send you confirmation.
- \* Parking maps will also be provided to show you where your vehicles may be parked.
- \* **Be Prepared**, such as having a small wagon, dolly, etc. to move food, ice, etc. into and out of the area during the celebration.
- \* No tents or motor homes are allowed in the park or surrounding area for sleeping purposes.
- \* Your space will be in the parking lot behind the City Park, along with other vendors or on John St.
- \* Absolutely no pets are allowed. Please make prior arrangements if your pets travel with you.
- \* We do not provide security, however there are security cameras on the premises, so be sure to lock up your unit properly.
- \* We will need proof of insurance prior to the show and of course you will need a food license.
- \* The area will be clean when you arrive. It is **your responsibility** to keep the area clean at all times, especially when you leave. If it wasn’t there when you arrived – it should not be there when you leave.
- \* The Chamber provides a dumpster for the festival vendors use at the south end of the vendor area.
- \* One 220 & 110 electric will be provided per space. If you need more, special arrangements will need to be made and extra charges may apply. Water is also available for your food wagon use.
- \* If you want to camp in one of our beautiful parks, we suggest that you contact one of them immediately upon acceptance into the show. Missaukee County Park – Crooked Lake Park 231-839-4945. Maple Grove Park (231) 839-4429. Both are full service parks. There is also rustic camping at Goose & Long Lake but reservations are not accepted, it is first come, first serve.

### Required Hours of Operation:

Friday, June 30	3:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. (Entertainment on Stage)
Saturday, July 1	10:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. (Children’s Day + Entertainment on Stage)
Sunday, July 2	12:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. (Celebrate Freedom & Battle of the Bands)
Monday, July 3	10:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. (Karaoke)
Tuesday, July 4	9:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. (Grand Parade 10 a.m., Entertainment on Stage, Car Drawing 10:15, Fireworks 10:30 p.m.)

These hours will be listed in our 10,000 celebration programs. If you cannot maintain these hours, please do not send in an application. You may choose to open earlier or remain open later. We want the celebration to be successful for you and to do so, we need your cooperation and all vendors open during these prime times.

Do not send in any deposit with your application. Volunteers, entertainers, judges, etc. will be handing you food coupons. After the celebration we will apply these to what is owed.
